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<b>Term</b>	Three years; subject to review and confirmation of re-appointment or of removal based on performance.
<b>Position Overview</b>	As the GLT constitutional area leader, you will champion the Global Action Team initiatives with a focus on leadership development. You will have a solid understanding of leadership development's initiatives, successes, and challenges in your constitutional area. Communicating with your leaders, listening to your leaders and understanding area specific needs will be the keys to your success. You will be proud knowing that your actions will equip Lions with the knowledge and skills to be successful leaders.
<b>Actions for Success</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Collaborates with your GMT and GST constitutional area leaders to further initiatives focused on leadership development, membership growth and expanding humanitarian service.</li><li>• Communicates with and seeks feedback from area leaders and fellow constitutional area leaders on a consistent basis.</li><li>• Provides ongoing motivation to leaders at all levels to achieve leadership development goals.</li><li>• Identifies potential and new leaders to participate in service, membership and leadership development opportunities.</li><li>• Participates in area leadership forum and collaborates with the constitutional area's Global Action Team leaders to conduct relevant seminars, events, and projects.</li><li>• Shares successes, opportunities and needs with the Global Action Team's vice-chairperson overseeing GLT and LCI staff.</li><li>• Encourages leaders to include diverse populations to participate in Global Action Team initiatives.</li></ul>
<b>Measuring Success</b>	At the end of each fiscal year, <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Increase the number of Lions participating in leadership development events by 10%.</li></ul>
<b>Recommended Qualifications</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Passionate about Lions, effectively promotes LCI Forward and is invested in the association's future.</li><li>• Leads by example; actively participating in leadership development programs.</li><li>• Able to use technology (Email, Microsoft Office, MyLCI, LCI website, social media).</li><li>• Graduate or faculty member of an Advanced Lions Leadership Institute or Faculty Development Institute, or other professional leadership program.</li></ul>
