

JUNG-YEOL CHOI
PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Jung-Yeol Choi, of Pusan, Republic of Korea, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 79th International Convention, held in Montreal, Quebec, Canada, July 9-12, 1996.

Director Choi is the president of a trading company.
