PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Paul Fan, of Hong Kong, Hong Kong, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 79th International Convention, held in Montreal, Quebec, Canada, July 9-12, 1996.

Past Director Fan is an information vendor and is also involved with finance and property.

A member of the Braemar Hill Lions Club since 1980, Past Director Fan has held many offices within the association, including club president, zone chairman, deputy district governor and district governor. He has been chairman of the Lions Nature Education Center, THE LION (Hong Kong edition) Publication Board, the Club Officers School and the District Membership Committee. In addition, he was vice chairman of the 34th OSEAL Forum, the host committee for the 75th Lions International Convention, the Lions Eye Bank and Research Foundation and the SightFirst China Project. In April 1997, the Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF) appointed Director Fan administrator of a US\$15.38 million SightFirst program grant which will support efforts to fight cataract in the People's Republic of China during the next five years.

In recognition of his service to the association, Past Director Fan has received numerous awards, including the 100% District Governor Award, two International President's Leadership Awards, three International President's Awards and an Ambassador of Good Will Award, the highest honor granted by the association to its members. He is also a Melvin Jones Fellow and a Lead Gift Donor to Campaign SightFirst.

In addition to his Lion activities, Past Director Fan is an adjudicator for immigration tribunal for the Hong Kong government and an advisory committee member to the Securities and Futures Commission. He has previously served as a council member of the Stock Exchange of Hong Kong. He is a justice of the peace for the Hong Kong government and a recipient of Her Majesty the Queen's Badge of Honour.

Past Director Fan and his wife, Mary, have one son and two daughters.
