PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Motohiro Fujii, of Fukuyama, Japan, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 82nd International Convention, held in San Diego, California, USA, June 28-July 2, 1999.
