PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Bjorn Gudmundsson, of Kopavogur, Iceland, served a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs after his election at the association's 62nd International Convention held in Montreal, Quebec, Canada, in June 1979.

Past Director Gudmundsson represents Iceland as a Trade Secretary at the Icelandic embassy in Copenhagen, Denmark. He has been part owner of a clothing firm since 1954 and has also been a member of the board of the Federation of Icelandic Industries and the Federal Commission for Industrial Education.

A charter member of the Kopavogur Lions Club, he has served as club secretary and president, district governor and as chairman of the district International Relations Committee.
