PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Dr. William Iannaccone, of Walnut Creek, California, USA, served a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs following his election at the association's 76th International Convention, held in Minneapolis, Minnesota, USA, July 6-9, 1993.

He is a Life Member and Helen Keller Fellow of the Lions Eye Foundation and a Life Member and recipient of the Alexander Graham Bell Award of the Ear of the Lion Foundation. He is also a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow.
