PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Adrian H. Johnson, of Faribault, Minnesota, USA, elected from Forest City, Iowa, served a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs after his election at the association's 59th International Convention held in Honolulu, Hawaii, USA, in June 1976.

Past Director Johnson is a retired professor of music.

A Lion since 1948, he has served in several major offices, including club president and district governor. He has also served as a trustee for the Iowa Lions Sight Conservation Foundation and chairman of the Glaucoma Committee.
