PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Dr. Roeinton B. Khambatta of Karachi, Pakistan, was elected to serve a two-year term as director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 45th annual convention in Nice, France, June 1962.

Past Director Khambatta is a retired physician. He spent 20 years in London, England, where he was a consultant cardiologist.
