

COLONEL ARSENE H. MILLIM
PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Colonel Arsene H. Millim, of Ehnen, Luxembourg, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 72nd annual convention, held in Miami Beach, Florida, USA, June 21-24, 1989.

Past Director Millim is an expert for disarmament matters at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, a Counsellor to The Permanent Mission of Luxembourg to The United Nations in New York and a military career officer.

A Lion and member of the Luxembourg International Lions Club since 1973, Past Director Millim has served as club president and district governor.

For his efforts on behalf of the association, Past Director Millim has received the 100% District Governor Award, three Extension Awards, a Certificate of Appreciation Award, four International President's Awards, and the Ambassador of Good Will Award, the highest honor granted by the association to its members. He is also a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow.

Active in the community, Past Director Millim is a member of many organizations, including the American-Luxembourg Association, the Czech-Slovak-Luxembourg Association, and the British-Luxembourg Society. He has been authorized by the government of the Czech Republic to exercise the consular functions of an honorary consul in the Grand-Duchy of Luxembourg. Past Director Millim has also received numerous military and civil distinctions.
