PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

H. H. "Ernie" Moore, of Cambridge, Ontario, Canada, served a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Club after his election at the association's 68th annual convention held in Dallas, Texas, USA, June 1985.

Past Director Moore worked for the Ontario government for over 34 years, and retired in April 1989.
