PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Rick Myers, of Fremont, Nebraska, USA, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 81st International Convention, held in Birmingham, England, June 29-July 3, 1998.
