PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Gaspar E. Ortiz Tapia, of the Republic of Panama, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 62nd International Convention, held in Montreal, Quebec, Canada, in June 1979.
