

**GORDON R. POST**  
**PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR**

Gordon R. Post, of Albuquerque, New Mexico, USA, served a two-year term as a director (from the state of New Jersey) of The International Association of Lions Clubs after his election at the association's 68th annual convention, held in Dallas, Texas, USA, June, 1985.

Past Director Post is a retired merchant.

Currently a member of the Albuquerque, New Mexico, Northeast Lions Club, Past Director Post joined the Maplewood, New Jersey, Lions Club in 1960. He has held many offices within the association, including club president, district governor, vice-president of the Eye/Ear Foundation of New Jersey and president of the New Mexico Lions Eye Foundation from 1994 to 1998. In recognition of his service, Past Director Post has received an Extension Award, the 100% District Governor's Award, International President's Commendation Awards, International President's Leadership Awards, a Membership Key and the Ambassador of Good Will Award, the highest honor granted to a member by the association. He is also a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow and a New Mexico Hap Beyer Fellow.

In addition to his Lion activities, Past Director Post has served his community as president of the Denville, N.J. Chamber of Commerce and was a board member of the New Jersey Foundation for the Blind, which named him Man of the Year in 1979. He has served as a member of the board of directors of the American Diabetes Association, New Jersey affiliate. Past Director Post served as Lions International Representative to the United Nations NGO Committee on Narcotics and Substance Abuse from 1989 to 1993.

Past Director Post's wife, Christel, is also a Lion and Melvin Jones Fellow.
