PAST INTERNATIONAL DIRECTOR

Drs Peter A. Vuurens, of Rotterdam, the Netherlands, was elected to serve a two-year term as a director of The International Association of Lions Clubs at the association's 81st International Convention, held in Birmingham, England, June 29-July 3, 1998.

Past Director Vuurens has retired as director of Delft Management B.V. and Princestad Management B.V. and retired earlier as chief executive university administrator of Delft University of Technology.

A member of the Delft Princestad Lions Club since 1987, Past Director Vuurens has held many offices within the association, including club president, zone chairman and district governor.
